

MT4/MT5 Installation on Mac

USER GUIDE

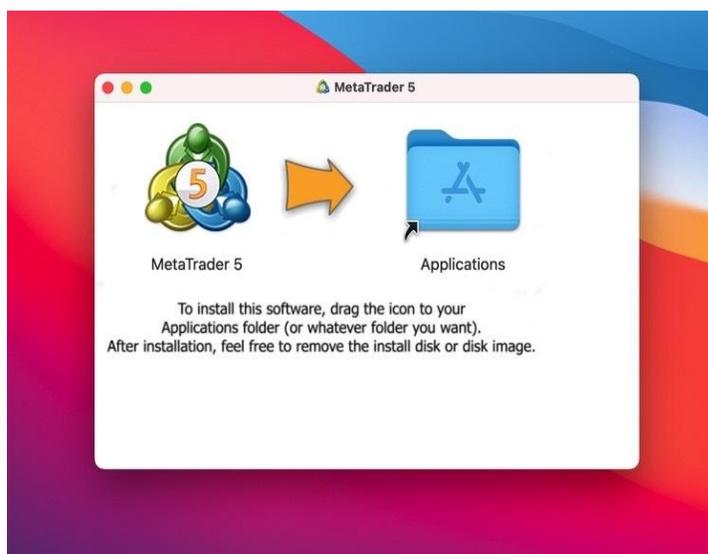
1. To install the terminal, download the "MetaTrader4.dmg" or "MetaTrader5.dmg" file.

2. Open the disc image file and drag it into Applications when prompted:

The standard terminal installation process with all its stages will start. This process may take several minutes.

If you want to make another MT4/5 Terminal installation, just repeat steps 1 and 2.

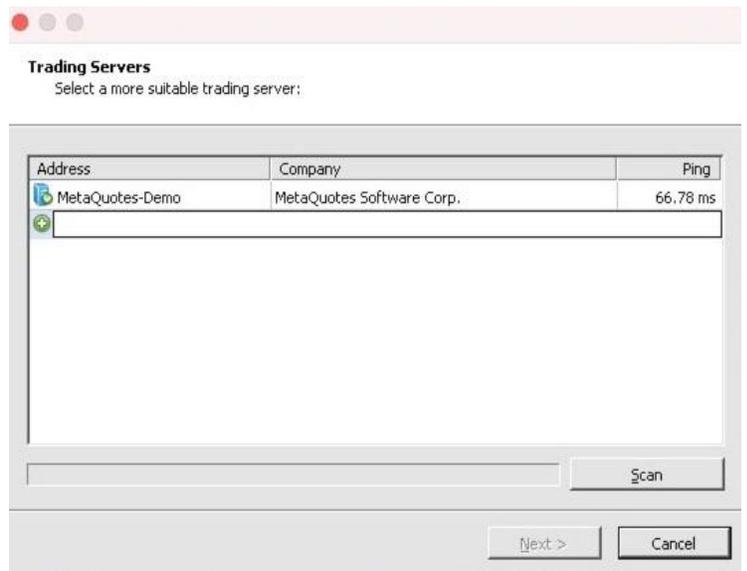
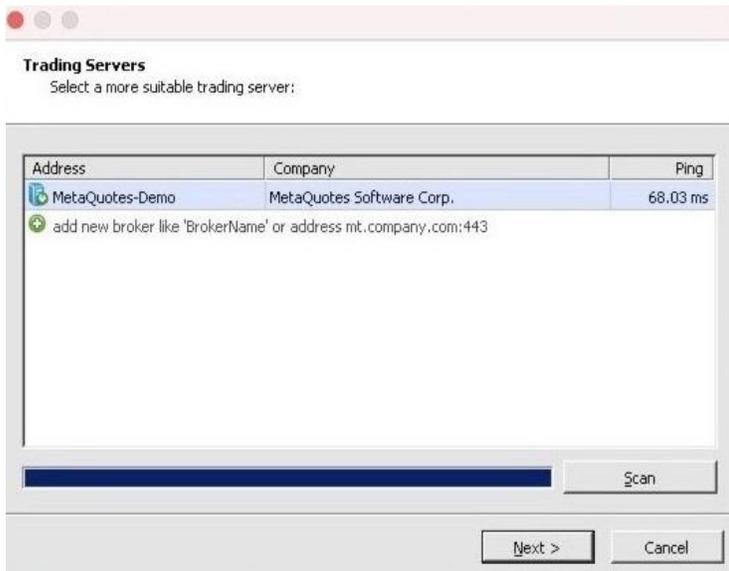
3. Once the installation is complete, MetaTrader should open automatically. If it does not, launch MetaTrader from your Applications folder.

If this is your first time using MetaTrader, you will need to:

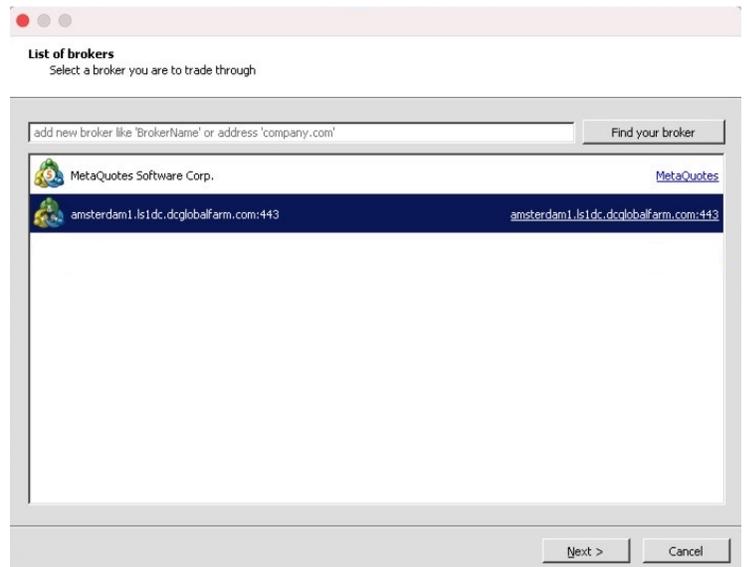
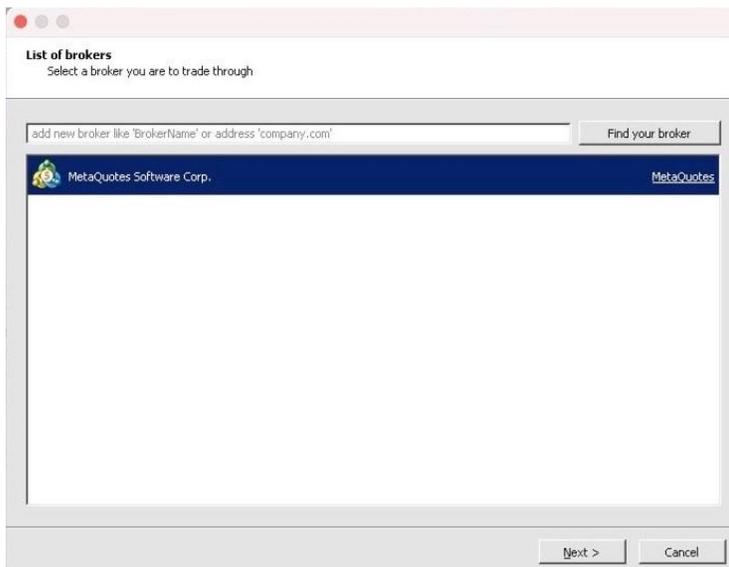
- MT4: Click on "add new broker". Inline edit to enter your domain name and click on "Scan"
- MT5: Enter the domain name into the "add new broker" box and click on "Find your broker"

Note that your MT4/5 domain name differs depending on the server that your trading account is connected to. Please see all domain names of the available servers here (MT4) and here (MT5).

4. Select the new domain and click "Next." You will then be prompted to log into your account.

- Enter your Login (Trading Account Number)
- Enter your Password (Trader's password)

These details were provided to you when you opened your trading account.

The domain name and server information you entered on the previous step will be added automatically.

Click Finish to complete the process.
